**A BILL**

To direct the Secretary of Defense and the Secretary of State to jointly submit to Congress a plan on Afghanistan, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Prioritize Evacuation  
5 of US Citizens in Afghanistan Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. CONGRESSIONAL DECLARATION.**

2 Congress declares the Biden Administration to  
3 prioritize and expedite the evacuation and relocation of the  
4 US citizens and their families in Afghanistan.

5 **SEC. 3. SENSE OF CONGRESS.**

6 It is the sense of Congress that the United States  
7 should—

8 (1) prioritize the repatriation of all United  
9 States persons in Afghanistan;

10 (2) make efforts to recover or destroy Depart-  
11 ment of Defense equipment and materials that were  
12 disposed or dispositioned to the military or govern-  
13 ment of Afghanistan, including property provided  
14 through foreign military sales and transfers of  
15 United States foreign excess property; and

16 (3) recover or destroy any and all Department  
17 of Defense equipment and materials, including weap-  
18 ons, vehicles, and aircraft, that have been left behind  
19 in Afghanistan to prevent such equipment and mate-  
20 rials from entering the possession of the Taliban.

21 **SEC. 4. DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE AND DEPARTMENT OF**  
22 **STATE JOINT PLAN ON AFGHANISTAN.**

23 The Secretary of Defense and the Secretary of State  
24 shall immediately jointly submit to Congress a report that  
25 includes—

1           (1) a plan to safely remove the approximately  
2           10,000 to 15,000 United States persons in Afghani-  
3           stan, as of the date of the enactment of this Act,  
4           from Afghanistan; and

5           (2) a detailed list and dollar amount of the De-  
6           partment of Defense equipment and materials that  
7           were not fully dispositioned at the time of the accel-  
8           erated withdraw.
