6	The Bretton Woods Agreements Act (22 U.S.C. 286
7	et seq.) is amended by adding at the end the following:
8	"SEC. 74. PREVENTING ALLOCATIONS OF SPECIAL DRAW-

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26 (a) REVIEW.—

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(1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Treas-1 2 ury, the Secretary of State, and the Administrator of the United States Agency for International Devel-3 4 opment shall jointly conduct a review of assistance 5 provided to nongovernmental organizations and 6 international organizations to ensure such assistance 7 is not being further provided to the Taliban or other 8 terrorist organizations or countries that harbor ter-9 rorist organizations in accordance with United 10 States anti-terrorism financing laws.

(2) REPORT.—Not later than 90 days after the
date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of
the Treasury, the Secretary of State, and the Administrator of the United States Agency for International Development shall jointly submit to Congress a report that contains the results of the review
conducted under paragraph (1).

18 (b) RECIPIENT REQUIREMENTS.—Not later than 180 19 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Treasury, the Secretary of State, and the 20 21 Administrator of the United States Agency for Inter-22 national Development shall each require prime awardees 23 of assistance to provide evidence that all sub-awardees of 24 such assistance are complying with United States anti-terrorism financing laws. 25
