A BILL

To designate certain organizations as foreign terrorist
organizations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Iranian Terror Preven-
5 tion Act”.

6 **SEC. 3. DESIGNATION AS FTO; IMPOSITION OF SANCTIONS.**

7 (a) DESIGNATION AS FTO.—Not later than 90 days
8 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
9 of State shall designate as a foreign terrorist organization

1 pursuant to section 219(a) of the Immigration and Na-
2 tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1189(a)) each of the following:

3 (1) Abu Fadl al-Abbas Brigades.

4 (2) Ansarallah (otherwise known as the
5 “Houthis”).

6 (3) Badr Organization.

7 (4) Fatemiyoun Brigade.

8 (5) Harakat Hezbollah al-Nujaba.

9 (6) Kata’ib al-Imam Ali.

10 (7) Kata’ib Jund al-Imam.

11 (8) Kata’ib Sayyad al Shuhada.

12 (9) Sarayya al-Jihad.

13 (10) Sarayya Khorasani.

14 (11) Zainabiyoun Brigade.

15 (12) Any foreign entity or organization that is
16 an agent of, affiliated with, or owned or controlled
17 by the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps.

18 (b) IMPOSITION OF SANCTIONS.—

19 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 60 days after
20 the date of the enactment of this Act, the President
21 shall determine whether to impose the sanctions de-
22 scribed in paragraph (3) on any organization listed
23 under paragraph (2) or any entity or organization
24 that is an agent, affiliate, or instrumentality, or

1 owned or controlled by an agent, affiliate, or instru-
2 mentality of an organization listed in paragraph (2).

3 (2) ORGANIZATIONS.—The following are organi-
4 zations with respect to which a sanction determina-
5 tion shall be made:

6 (A) Abu Fadl al-Abbas Brigades.

7 (B) Badr Organization.

8 (C) Kata'ib al-Imam Ali.

9 (D) Kata'ib Jund al-Imam.

10 (E) Sarayya al-Jihad.

11 (F) Sarayya Khorasani.

12 (3) SANCTIONS DESCRIBED.—The sanctions de-
13 scribed in this subsection are sanctions applicable
14 with respect to a foreign person pursuant to Execu-
15 tive Order 13224 (50 U.S.C. 1701 note; relating to
16 blocking property and prohibiting transactions with
17 persons who commit, threaten to commit, or support
18 terrorism).

19 (c) REPORT.—

20 (1) SECRETARY OF STATE REPORT.—Not later
21 than 180 days after the date of enactment of this
22 Act, and every 180 days thereafter, the Secretary of
23 State, in consultation with the Secretary of Com-
24 merce, shall submit to Congress a report on any new
25 entities meeting the requirements for—

1 (A) designation as a foreign terrorist orga-
2 nization; or

3 (B) imposition of sanctions with respect to
4 a foreign person pursuant to Executive Order
5 13224 (50 U.S.C. 1701 note; relating to block-
6 ing property and prohibiting transactions with
7 persons who commit, threaten to commit, or
8 support terrorism).

9 (2) PRESIDENTIAL REPORT.—The President
10 shall submit to Congress a report not later than 60
11 days after a determination has been made under
12 subsection (b) on whether the organizations listed
13 under such subsection have sanctions imposed pur-
14 suant to Executive Order 13224 and shall provide a
15 detailed explanation should any such organization
16 not be sanctioned.
