**A BILL**

To designate certain organizations as foreign terrorist  
organizations.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Iranian Terror Preven-  
5       tion Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. DESIGNATION AS FTO; IMPOSITION OF SANCTIONS.**

7       (a) DESIGNATION AS FTO.—Not later than 90 days  
8       after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary  
9       of State shall designate as a foreign terrorist organization

1 pursuant to section 219(a) of the Immigration and Na-  
2 tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1189(a)) each of the following:

- 6 (4) Harakat Hezbollah al-Nujaba.
- 7 (5) Kata'ib al-Imam Ali.

- 9 (7) Kata'ib Sayyad al Shuhada.
- 10 (8) Sarayya al-Jihad.
- 11 (9) Sarayya Khorasani.
- 12 (10) Zainabiyoun Brigade.

- 14 (12) Turkmen Brigades.
- 15 (13) Babylon Brigades.

12 (b) IMPOSITION OF SANCTIONS.—

13 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 60 days after  
14 the date of the enactment of this Act, the President  
15 shall determine whether to impose the sanctions de-  
16 scribed in paragraph (3) on any organization listed  
17 under paragraph (2) or any entity or organization  
18 that is an agent, affiliate, or instrumentality, or  
19 owned or controlled by an agent, affiliate, or instru-  
20 mentality of an organization listed in paragraph (2).

21 (2) ORGANIZATIONS.—The following are organi-  
22 zations with respect to which a sanction determina-  
23 tion shall be made:

22 (3) SANCTIONS DESCRIBED.—The sanctions de-  
23 scribed in this subsection are sanctions applicable  
24 with respect to a foreign person pursuant to Execu-  
25 tive Order 13224 (50 U.S.C. 1701 note; relating to

1 blocking property and prohibiting transactions with  
2 persons who commit, threaten to commit, or support  
3 terrorism).

4 (c) REPORT.—

5 (1) SECRETARY OF STATE REPORT.—Not later  
6 than 180 days after the date of enactment of this  
7 Act, and every 180 days thereafter, the Secretary of  
8 State, in consultation with the Secretary of Com-  
9 merce, shall submit to Congress a report on any new  
10 entities meeting the requirements for—

11 (A) designation as a foreign terrorist orga-  
12 nization; or

13 (B) imposition of sanctions with respect to  
14 a foreign person pursuant to Executive Order  
15 13224 (50 U.S.C. 1701 note; relating to block-  
16 ing property and prohibiting transactions with  
17 persons who commit, threaten to commit, or  
18 support terrorism).

19 (2) PRESIDENTIAL REPORT.—The President  
20 shall submit to Congress a report not later than 60  
21 days after a determination has been made under  
22 subsection (b) on whether the organizations listed  
23 under such subsection have sanctions imposed pur-  
24 suant to Executive Order 13224 and shall provide a

- 1 detailed explanation should any such organization
- 2 not be sanctioned.
