## A BILL

To amend title 1, United States Code, to clarify that certain tax exemptions are not treated as Federal financial assistance.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Safeguarding Charity
- 5 Act".

### 1 SEC. 2. FEDERAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE NOT TO INCLUDE

- 2 CERTAIN TAX BENEFITS.
- 3 (a) In General.—Chapter 1 of title 1, United
- 4 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 5 lowing new section:

#### 6 "SEC. 9. FEDERAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE.

- 7 "In the case of any organization described in sub-
- 8 section (c) or (d) of section 501 of the Internal Revenue
- 9 Code of 1986 or any organization described in section
- 10 401(a) of such Code, for purposes of any Federal law,
- 11 rule, or regulation, unless explicitly provided otherwise,
- 12 the term 'Federal financial assistance,' or any other term
- 13 referring to assistance provided by the Federal Govern-
- 14 ment, shall not include any exemption from Federal in-
- 15 come tax.".
- 16 (b) Clerical Amendment.—The table of contents
- 17 for chapter 1 of title 1, United States Code, is amended
- 18 by adding at the end the following new item:
  - "9. Federal financial assistance.".
- 19 (c) Rule of Construction.—Nothing in this sec-
- 20 tion or the amendments made by this section shall be con-
- 21 strued to imply that an exemption from Federal income
- 22 taxes under section 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code
- 23 of 1986 constituted assistance from the Federal Govern-
- 24 ment for periods before the date of the enactment of this
- 25 Act.
