3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Valid Benefits Act".

5 SEC. 2. VERIFICATION OF ELIGIBILITY FOR FEDERAL BEN-

EFITS FOR CERTAIN ELDERLY INDIVIDUALS.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The head of each Federal depart-8 ment or agency that provides Federal benefits to individ-

uals who have attained 105 years of age or more shall
 take appropriate steps to ensure, on a semiannual basis,
 that each such individual remains eligible for such bene fits.

5 (b) AUTHORITY TO ISSUE REGULATIONS.—The head
6 of each Federal department or agency specified in para7 graph (1) may issue regulations to implement this section.
8 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This section shall apply with
9 respect to payments of Federal benefits made on or after
10 December 31, 2025.
