RE: Letter of Support for federal partnership Wild & Scenic River designation for the Myakka River

Dear Ms. Doubek-Racine,

The Coastal & Heartland National Estuary Partnership (CHNEP) is pleased to provide this letter of support for federal partnership Wild & Scenic River designation for the Myakka River.

The CHNEP is part of the US EPA National Estuary Program and was created by Section 320 of the Clean Water Act to protect and preserve the estuaries and their watersheds from Lemon Bay to Estero Bay in Southwest Florida – recognized as “estuaries of national significance” by Congress. The Myakka River is within the CHNEP area. Long-term management, preservation and restoration activities of the CHNEP area are guided by our [Comprehensive Conservation and Management Plan](#) (CCMP), collectively developed and implemented by all of the local, state, and federal entities in the Partnership.

The CHNEP’s governing body, the [Policy Committee](#), is comprised of elected leaders from all 10-counties (Polk, Hardee, Highlands, DeSoto, Manatee, Sarasota, Charlotte, Glades, Hendry and Lee) as well as many of the cities therein, in addition to state and federal officials from various natural resource management agencies. At its recent January 23, 2025 meeting, the Policy Committee heard a [presentation](#) from yourself and after carefully deliberation, unanimously voted to support the reintroduction of related legislation ([The Myakka Wild & Scenic River Act of 2024](#)) to designate 34 miles of the Myakka River in Sarasota County as part of the Partnership National Wild and Scenic Rivers system. This action would be consistent with furthering multiple CHNEP CCMP water quality improvement, hydrological restoration, and fish, wildlife and habitat protection actions.
