The League of Women Voters of Sarasota County has an over 50-year history of working with county government and local stakeholders to promote responsible stewardship over our natural resources. In that time we have served on the county's planning commission and advisory boards, the Southwest Florida Water Management District, and the Myakka River Management Coordinating Council.

The Myakka River, its watershed and its surrounding state park are particular gems within southwest Florida.
