## TIES BY NON-U.S. CITIZENS.

(a) PROHIBITION.—Notwithstanding any other provi-6 7 sion of law, except as provided in subsection (b), a person who is not a citizen of the United States may not access
 or enter any site or facility owned, operated, or leased by
 the Department of Energy.

- 4 (b) EXCEPTION.—The prohibition under subsection
  5 (a) shall not apply with respect to any person who is a
  6 citizen of Australia, Canada, New Zealand, or the United
  7 Kingdom.
- 8 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The prohibition under sub9 section (a) shall take effect on the date that is 60 days
  10 after the date of enactment of this Act.
- (d) IMPLEMENTATION.—Not later than 60 days after
  the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Energy
  shall revise any regulations, guidelines, policies, and procedures as necessary to carry out this Act.
